**A** unique range of humorous cardboard automata for you to cut out and make.

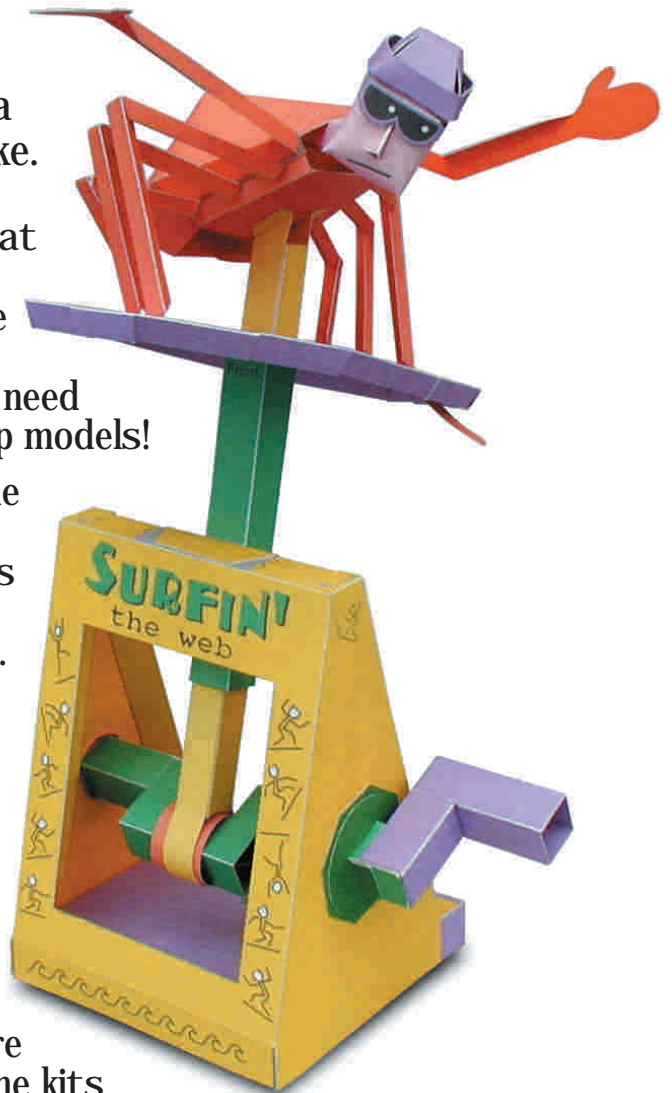

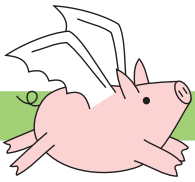

Mexican Wave. n. the rippling effect produced when the spectators in successive rows of a sports stadium stand up while raising their arms then sit down.

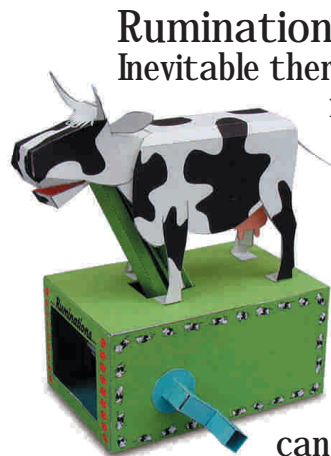
Mexican Peck. n. the rippling effect produced when successive waves of chickens peck at the harsh baked earth in search of morsels of food. Now immortalised in card.

With the crafty use of the crank slider mechanism the normally earth bound porker can fly! As the handle on this model is turned the wings flap and the legs move up and down.

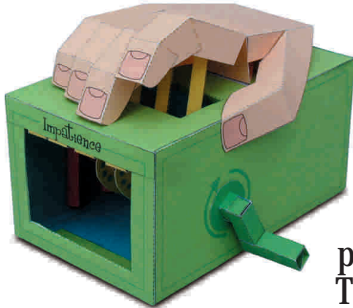


### Ruminations.

Cutting, scoring, folding and gluing are all worthwhile and fulfilling activities but none require strenuous exertion.

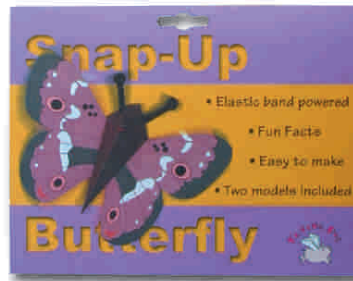
The hitherto lethargic Cardboard Engineer can now create this unique personal training machine. By participating in daily finger bend exercises new levels of digital dexterity

In each kit there are two models, one already coloured and one for you to colour in. Also included in each of the kits is a game related to the animal and a selection of fascinating facts.



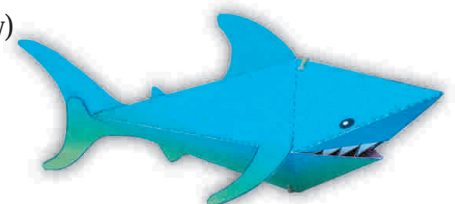
(Snap-Up Frog)
